EUROLAB General Assembly approves the revised Articles of Associations, elects new Vice President and Board Members

During the EUROLAB Annual Meetings, on 16-17 April 2026, in Varna Bulgaria, the EUROLAB General Assembly approved the revised Articles of Association, and elected the new Vice President and Board Members

On 17 April, during the General Assembly, the EUROLAB Members voted in favour of opening the EUROLAB Association to laboratories and other conformity assessment bodies, by approving the revised EUROLAB Articles of Association. This vote represents a vote of confidence for the future of EUROLAB, seeking to promote the development and evolution of the organisation by mirroring the already existing structure of the national members and enhancing the representation of laboratories and other conformity assessment bodies.



EUROLAB will thus revise its current membership categories, opening its membership to the 'White Countries' where EUROLAB currently does not have members, as well as enhancing its collaboration and membership to other sectoral organisations active in the conformity assessment sector.
